Emeritus Prof. Henry Lai, PhD (USA) has a long research career at the University of Washington, focused on the biological effects of non-ionizing electromagnetic fields (from extremely-low frequency to radiofrequency) and their possible medical applications with research end points covering molecular biology, neurochemistry, and behaviour. He had a further interest in the development of artemisinins and its analogs for cancer treatment and prevention. From 2009 to present, Prof. Lai has served as Editor-in-Chief of the international peer-reviewed journal Electromagnetic Biology and Medicine. He has been an Honorary Professor, at the Tropical Medicine Institute, Guangzhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, China from 2002 to present. Prof. Lai has published over 100 peer-reviewed research publications. In 2011, The Seattle Magazine named Prof. Lai as one of the most influential people in Seattle in 2011.
